Description

Building Families for Children, Inc. (BFC) is a faith-based, family services nonprofit agency located in Columbia, Maryland. The mission of BFC is to share the love of Christ by helping Maryland's most vulnerable children thrive in families. BFC has a part-time opening (32 hours/week) for a Family Support Coordinator through our Safe Families for Children® program. Safe Families for Children® is a network of Christian families that extends the community safety net by providing parents in need with a loving sanctuary for their children in time of crisis.

Position

The Family Support Coordinator is responsible for the intake of families in need of support and ensuring families are supported by assigned case coaches and other Safe Families for Children support volunteers. This position also assists the Safe Families team with the overall planning of the program including developing relationships with churches and referral sources and assisting churches in recruiting host families, family friends and case coaches.

Requirements

Bachelor's degree or equivalent years of experience in human services with families and children. Experience with volunteer coordination in a faith-based environment preferred. Experience might include, but is not limited to, internship/externship experiences, volunteering, or paid work experience in the human services field.

Applicants must possess the ability to work a flexible schedule with some evening and weekend hours, have reliable transportation and be compatible with a faith-based approach and environment.
